



Overview

- PlanetLab (www.planet-lab.org) is a global research network that consisted of 862 nodes at 448 sites in May 2008.
- HIIT PlanetLab Gateway provides a new web interface for running experiments on PlanetLab.
- Complete PlanetLab experiments can be run using the HIIT PlanetLab Gateway web interface all the way from choosing the nodes to running the experiment and finally collecting the resulting log files.



Features



Slice management

- Log in using your PlanetLab credentials.
- Sort nodes based on their status (up/down), available memory, latency, etc.
- · Arrange nodes in different groups.
- Send HTTP requests to a node or a group of nodes.
- Send shell commands to a node or a group of nodes.
- View the result logs of each executed HTTP request and shell command.
- Save log files to your local hard drive.
